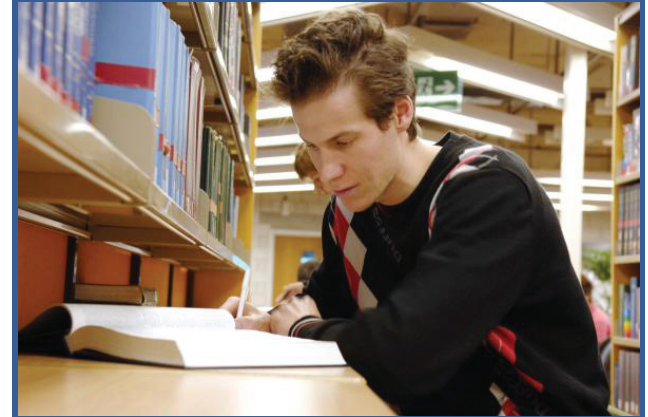

What are the GED Tests?

The GED (General Educational Development) Tests cover the same subjects that people study in high school.

The five subject areas are:

- Language Arts, Writing
- Language Arts, Reading
- Social Studies
- Science
- Mathematics

You will not be required to know all the information that is usually taught in high school. However, you will be tested on your ability to read and process information, solve problems, and communicate effectively.

When you pass the GED Tests, you will receive a diploma or certificate that is equivalent to a high school diploma. Employers as well as admissions officers in colleges and universities accept the GED certificate as they would a high school diploma.

A Three-Step Process

1. Pre-GED Preparation
2. GED Preparation
3. Taking the GED Tests
