We offer a variety of programming. This fall, we focused on our English language learners, ongoing digital literacy training, and foundational learning. We have already offered GED preparation and examinations times and will continue to add to that in the new year. We have welcomed several newcomers to Stettler who are building on their English language skills – and we learn from them as well, although they may not realize that! We are all grateful to be working and learning from these clients.



If you, or someone you know, is interested in the medical fields, the Health Care Aide program starts in January right here in Stettler, and the Practical Nurse program (leading to an LPN licence) starts in September. Call us to learn more! Through our connections with Red Deer Polytechnic, Olds College, and Norquest College, we are prepared to offer a Medical Device Reprocessing Certificate online to anyone interested.

As the working world and government agencies continue to move more and more towards online access, registrations, updates, and usage, it is more important than ever that everyone, regardless of age, has the skills necessary to function in a digital age. We are here to help you do so! We currently have digital drop-in sessions every Thursday from 10 a.m. to noon, and we will continue to offer that. We will expand our offerings to include scheduled classes in fourweek blocks for Computer/Tablet basics, Microsoft 365 Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Outlook; Google Suite, and for those who find new phones under the tree, iPhone, and Android classes!



Did you know that anyone working in a public kitchen, whether you are a caterer, food worker, or volunteer, requires some level of food safety training? It's easy to obtain, and we have the tools and online access to allow you to complete your basic level training or food safety certificate, which is good for 3 years. We can offer time for entire teams to complete the course or do individual sessions at a time of your choice. We'll even offer you coffee and a snack!
